Seat reservations

Reservations are free when you buy an appropriate ticket for a reservable ScotRail service and are available up to 12 weeks in advance. Please note that not all ScotRail services are reservable.

Buying your ticket

To avoid queues, you can buy your ticket in advance at [www.scotrail.co.uk](http://www.scotrail.co.uk), or by calling our Telesales team on 0344 811 0141 between 0700 and 2200, seven days a week. All major credit / debit cards are accepted.

PlusBus is an add-on to your train ticket giving unlimited bus travel on most bus services around the whole urban area of your origin or destination.

Rail & Sail

ScotRail works with Scotland's ferry operators to provide combined Rail & Sail tickets.

Cycles

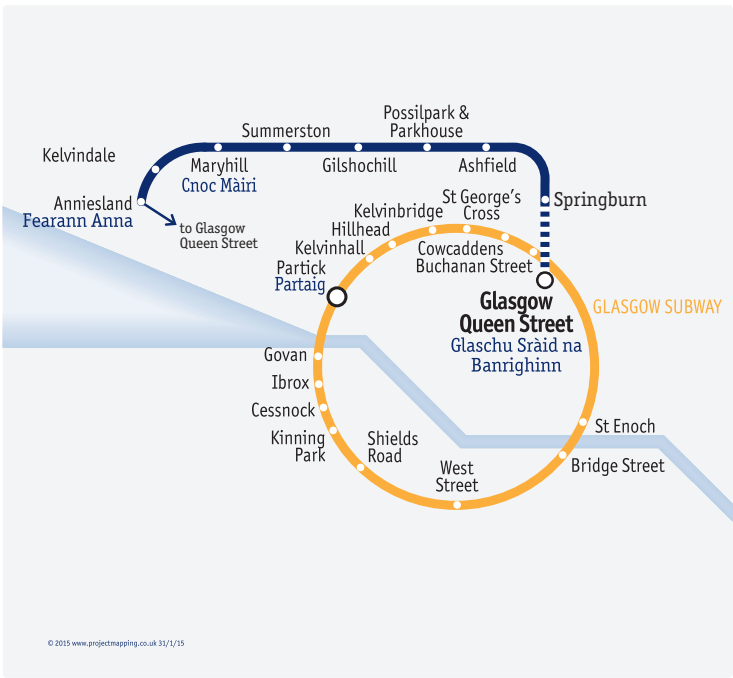
Please note that trains may divide en route – check with staff that you are in the correct portion of the train.
